

**Fremont Veterinary Hospital**  
**Income Guidelines for Low-cost**  
**Spays and Neuters**

Fremont Veterinary Hospital has received a grant through the **Colorado Pet Overpopulation Fund** for low-income pet owners. This is a non-profit organization that was established through the Colorado State Legislature. Their goal is to reduce the number of unwanted animals while also reducing the number of euthanasias. The most efficient way to do this is by sterilizing pets not used for purebred breeding purposes. This fund has provided an option for low-income pet owners who currently are unable to afford the spaying and neutering costs. To take advantage of this program, you must meet the following criteria:

- 1) You must reside in Fremont, Custer, Park or Teller County.
- 2) You must meet the following income limits:

**These services not covered include, but are not limited to, vaccinations, pre-anesthetic blood screening, and additional surgical procedures found at the time of the surgery. Females that are in heat or pregnant, and/or males with undescended testicles are at an additional cost to the owner.**
